This is a full-time position which is designed to bring into balance service to others with the volunteer's individual spiritual practice. We are seeking candidates who desire to engage in the core spiritual practices of generosity, patience, personal ethics, joyful effort, & meditation.



Working at the direction of the Head Cook the Assistant Cook will:

Help with the preparation and clean up of 2 meals per day for retreatants, staff, teachers, & guests; prepare meals when the head cook is away; provide a variety of other logistical support for the kitchen & retreat center as needed. A typical work week is 35 hours over a contiguous 5 day period.

A modest stipend, private apartment with territorial views, and all meals are provided. Candidates who have a sincere desire to integrate genuine spiritual practice with daily life, and who are willing to meet the rewarding challenges inherent to life in a small volunteer community, will be given high priority. Short trial periods are available in the kitchen where the food is thoughtfully crafted and laughter is a common staple. Non-Buddhist applicants are welcome and encouraged to apply.
