


Minutes:

- 2016 Budget Final Review and Approval
 - Discussion:
 - Program budget changes as classes are added to the Calendar. Typically we add programs but don't subtract (cancel) programs. Since there is very little room on the schedule, not many programs can be added.
 - Dues projection: what has been the increase in Monthly dues during 2015? Discussing the logic of Tab #8
 - Key Operating Ratio is % of base operating expenses are covered by Dues and Donations. Idea is to not be overly reliant on program income. Portland's Key Operating Ratio has been roughly stable. Salaries and

Benefits are about 52% of the budgeted base operating expenses.



- Looking at expenses as a percent of total projected of \$91,213.
- For "Total 6300 · Program Expense" budget strategy: increasing program revenue while decreasing program expenses as affected by the kinds of programs offered.
- Looking at Transfer to Center of the Mandala. More than half are direct individual donations from individuals to the center of the mandala. The sources are as follows:



■ Abbey's hours. Her role is very important for Center operation. Lisa is interested in having a set of designated hours for Abbey. Strengthening administration will lead to increased revenues and increased ability to relocate.

Decisions:

■ Plan to approve transfer to the center of the mandala budget as shown in the proposed budget, but make further decisions about increasing transfers early in 2016 and again quarterly.

Action Items:

- **Broad agreement:** Increase Abbey's 2 hours and 4% hourly wage as described in Tab #7.

We are in process of scheduling a meeting in early Jan. with Ashoka Credit Union to discuss what they could offer us for Financing a mortgage. Myself, Bettina, Jack and Doug will participate.

Communications

Overview & current issues

- Publishing links to the Amazon Smile program and Anandi's site in the Newsletter might generate a bit of revenue, but it raises the question of advertising and whether we should provide the service to commercial entities and under what conditions.
- There was some confusion and uncertainty around setting up the Khyung Dzong Regimental Dön Season Annual Maneuvers in the calendar. Linda Pardun offered to prepare a Coordinator's Manual for the Kasung, but I wonder whether other groups could use the accumulated wisdom of the P&E sphere?
- The report on information technology activity and resources in the mandala has still not been submitted to the Sakyong, but we have been told that the draft looks good. It will be presented to him on January 7.
- Most of the forms on our website have now been converted to Gravity Forms, away from the more fragile Google Forms. Only <u>the teachers scholarship request form</u> remains to be converted.
- The converted <u>program evaluation form</u> generates an email message with a participant's comments. Who should receive the feedback? The individual teacher? the P&E Director? The Shastri?


